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THE SINDHU RESETTLEMENT CORPORATION LIMITED (Builder of Adipur - Gandhidham Township)

Mahatma Gandhi, The father of nation was very keen that uprooted Sindhis during the partition of the country in 1947 could be settled at one place in Kutch, which was in vicinity of Sindh, with similarity in language, customs and religious beliefs. He discussed the matter with Bhai Pratab Dialdas as well with Maharao of Kutch, to whom he requested to provide the land for rehabilitation and resettlement of Sindhi Hindu migrants from West Pakistan.

Maharao on the recommendation of Gandhiji graciously agreed to the

proposal and allotted 15000 acres of the land in the eastern part of Kutch for the purpose to THE SINDHU RESETTLEMENT CORPORATION LIMITED, set up in 1948.

The Foundation stone of Gandhidham township was laid on 12th February 1948, the twelfth day of Gandhiji's martyrdom, when portion of his ashes were immersed in Kandla creek by Acharya J. B.Kripalani and Bhai Pratab, the founder Chairman and Managing Director of SRC

Ltd. respectively. It was also decided to name the new township "Gandhidham" to acknowledge Gandhiji's role in resettling uprooted Sindhis with dignity and honour, to occupy their rightful place in India, as they too had fought for the freedom of the country and had sacrificed their whole province Sindh.

The grant of land to SRC Ltd. was confirmed by Govt. of India in 1952, however the land was subsequently reduced from 15000 acres to 2600 acres for which revised lease agreement was signed with Govt. of India on 28th Nov. 1955.

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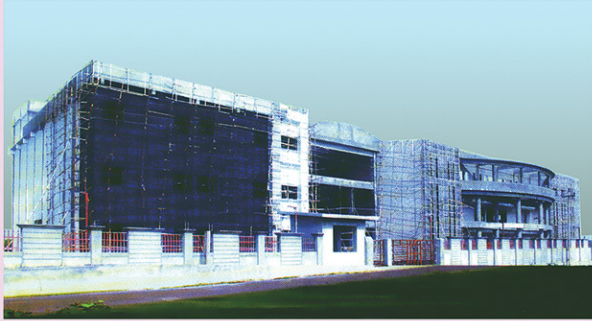

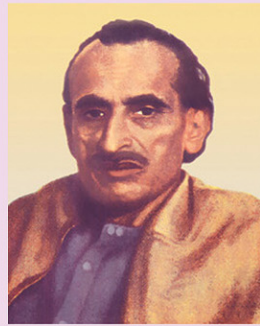

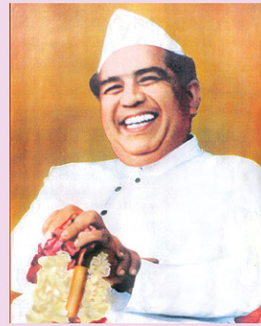

For development of the newly acquired barren land SRC Ltd. raised the capital by offering 10235 Shares of Rs.1000/- each to the immigrants entitling them to get one plot of land against one share by paying the actual development charges. Govt. of India also subscribed 25 % of the capital by securing 5000 shares of SRC Ltd.

Govt. of India gave its full support to develop the new township of Gandhidham to act as a port town of Kandla, a major port planned on western coast to replace Karachi which was ceded to Pakistan after partition.

The first master plan of Gandhidham was prepared by an Italian Architect Mario Baccheocci in 1949. A final and comprehensive Master plan was subsequently prepared by an American town planning Consultants M/s. Adams Howards and Greeley.

Bhai Pratab, the first Managing Director of SRC Ltd was a man of a great courage and vision. He took up the challenge and offered a novel incentive scheme to the new settlers, who killed scorpions and snakes to clear the land for developing the township for displaced persons. Besides residential houses, he constructed shops to ensure and allotted them to new settlers at most nominal rentals/hire purchase to earn their livelihood.

At the initial stage, he also developed roads and other civic services till formation of Municipality. He also established a Power House to provide electricity till the State Agency took over. He developed water resources by boring the tube wells at Viri and Nagalpur and provided water supply to the people, till the Municipality came in existence.

To provide the employment to thousand of Sindhi settlers who left the Refugee Camps of Kalyan Pimpri, Devlali, to start a new permanent life here, Bhai Pratab set up RCC pipe factory and Besser Block making plant, a Spinning Mill, a city Bus service.

SRC Ltd also took up many construction projects floated by Govt. Agencies : Jetty No. 1 of Kandla Port in collaboration with German firm M/s. Mckenzie's Heinrich Butzer (India) was completed in record time - Similarly civil works at Jhakhau Port, RCC bridge and road over Nakti Creek, Tapar Dam, Gandhidham Railway Station building and Railway Staff quarters.

After the lead given by Acharya Kripalani and Bhai Pratab the reins of SRC were taken over by succeeding Chairmen, Barrister Hotchand Advani, Mr. Sanmukh Israni, Padamshri Jiwanlal Jairamdas and other eminent Personalities of Sindhi Community, to carry forward the work of Resettlement inspite of many hurdles faced by the Corporation from time to time. During the past one decade under the able stewardship of Madam Smt. Nirmala Gajwani the present Chairperson of SRC Ltd. all the difficulties have been surmounted. Corporation has allotted the land to various Government departments like post and Telegraph, Gujarat Electricity Board, Police Department and Gandhidham Municipality for the betterment of township. From its own resources, it has renovated Gandhiji's Samadhi, and also erected Samadhi of Bhai Pratab. For beautification of Adipur township Adisar Lake (Sadhubela) with Boating and Children Park has been developed. Bhai Pratab's statue has been erected in the middle of the lake. In Gandhidham an amusement Park "Sindhu Baug" with Children's Park has been established. "Sindhu Bhawan" a Cultural Centre with club facility is under construction. N.R. Malkani Public Library in Nat Mandir, and Shiv Mandir (Nirvasteswar) are the other attractions of the town visited by hundreds of citizens and tourists.

SRC Ltd has provided many plots to NGO's like Maitri Mandal for setting up many schools & B.Ed college, Gandhidham Collegiate Board to set up dozens of Tolani Colleges, Arts, Science, Commerce, Law, Management, Polytechnics etc, Indian Institute of Sindhology for establishing Bharti Sindhu Vidyapeeth a Sindhi Cultural University, and Maleer, writers, artists and scholars village.

Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru during his first visit to Gandhidham on 10th January 1952 was so impressed by the development of township that he proclaimed in a Public meeting "Hence - forth whoever wishes to construct a new planned township anywhere in India, I would like to advise them to follow the example set up by Bhai Pratab and his dedicated team of SRC Ltd.

Activities of Sindhology

Rock Concert by Solar Punch

Ms. Manju Mirwani and Ms. Champa Chetnani read out two plays which they had presented at a seminar recently held at Ahmedabad.

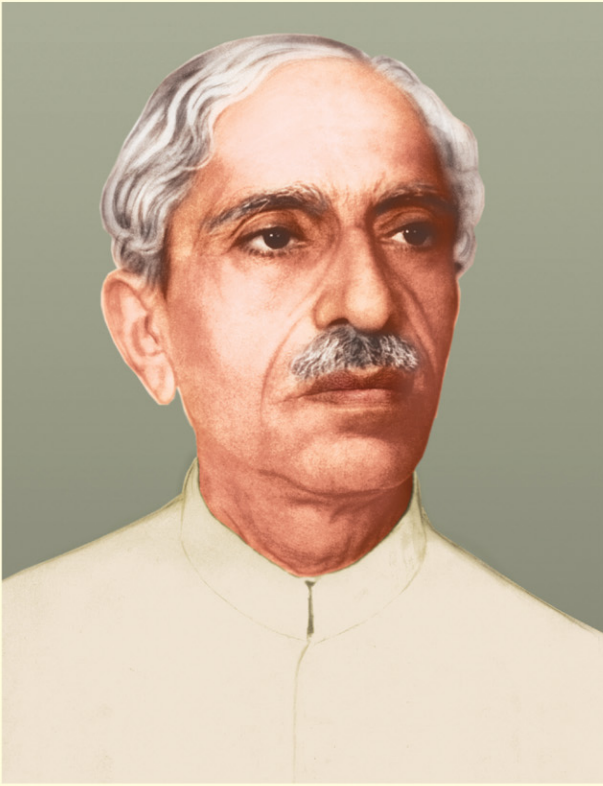
The member strength of M.U.Malkani Dramatic Club has reached 99, out of which 10 are students from Schools.

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The Pride of Sindhi Community

Narayandas Ratanmal Malkani - Padam Bhushan Narayandas Ratanmal Malkani (1890 - 1974) A noted social worker, freedom fighter, eminent educationist,



member of Rajya Sabha for two terms, a close confidant of Mahatma Gandhi, played an active role in crusade against untouchability and upliftment of most downtrodden Shudra class of scavengers, whom Gandhiji lovingly nicknamed 'Harijans'.

N.R.Malkani was born on August 1890 at Hyderabad (Sindh). His father Ratanmal was the member of Brahma Samaj and used to take Narayan to Brahma Mandir every Sunday for prayers.

After completing his matriculation, in December 1905, N.R. joined a college first at Baroda and later Ferguson College Pune, but finished his B.A. from D.J.Sindh College Karachi. He also passed his L.L.B. exam in 1912, as his father was keen that he should become a lawyer. But Narayan chose for himself role of educationist and became a teacher in N.J. High school Karachi for eight months. He soon joined C.B.B.College in Muzzafarpur (Bihar) as professor of Economics, where Jiwatram Bhagwandas Kripalani was already posted. Both of them stayed together from 1913 to 1917, when Kripalani left to join Gandhiji's non co-operation movement.

When Gandhiji came to Muzzafarpur in 1917, to start Champaran movement of Indigo workers, Kripalani arranged his accommodation in Malkani's house.

During his second visit to Muzzafarpur in 1920, Gandhiji asked Malkani, "Professor what next?" Malkani there and then made up his mind to join Gandhiji's freedom movement. Gandhiji asked him to join Gujarat Vidyapeeth at Ahmedabad, where Acharya Assudomal Gidwani was already working as Principal.

N.R.Malkani returned to Sindh in 1927, after spending seven years in Gujarat and joined Sindh National College Hyderabad as Professor of Economics. Malkani involved himself in flood and famine relief work in Sindh during 1927-1929. When Gandhiji visited Sindh in 1928, Malkani accompanied him, during his tour of Sindh. At Gandhiji's behest, he came to stay at Sabarmati Ashram and joined 'Harijan Shewak Sangh' a movement started by him to remove untouchability, with Thakkar Bapa as its first General Secretary and Malkani his able assistant.

Malkani courted arrest in 1930 during Salt Satyagraha and was imprisoned at Yerwada Jail. All political prisoners were released in March 1931 after Gandhi Irwin Pact. All India Congress session was held at Karachi in 1931, Malkani took an active part as an organizer. He was once again put behind bars in October 1931 and released in April 1932. He was arrested again during Quit India Movement in 1942 and released in 1945. In the jail he translated many books written by Gandhiji as well autobiography of Gandhi and Nehru in Sindhi. N.R.Malkani has written 20 books in Sindhi and English which include "Dhampada" and "Bhagwan Budh" originally written by Dharmanand Kausambji and "Anardana" & his autobiography "Nirali Zindagi".

After the partition Nehru appointed him as Deputy High Commissioner of India in Karachi under Shri SriPrakash to evacuate Hindu Sindhis safely to India through Rail, Road, Sea routes. He accepted another appointment of Government of India to assist rehabilitation of Hindu Sindhis in Rajasthan. After this assignment, he came to Delhi with his family and stayed at Harijan Colony at Kingsway.

N.R.Malkani was nominated member of Parliament (Rajya Sabha) for two terms from 1952 to 1962. He was conferred Padam Bhushan Award in 1973 by Govt. of India. He moved to Gandhidham a new township of Sindhis built by his close friend Bhai Pratab Dialdas in 1966, where he died in the year 1974.

N.R.Malkani shall be remembered for his excellent work for improving the condition of scavengers, by submitting well researched "Report of Scavenging Conditions Enquiring Committee" (also known as Malkani Committee Report) to Govt. of India, which changed the fate of unfortunate scavengers who had to carry human excreta on their heads.

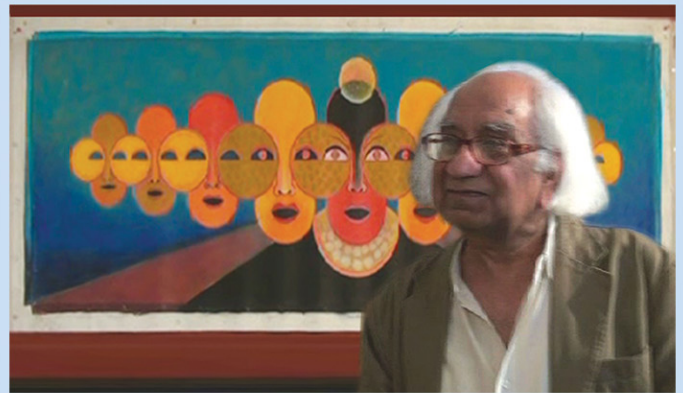

The Pride of Sindhi Community

Kewal Ratanmal Malkani - An author, journalist, an active politician, Vice President of Bharatiya Janta Party, member of Rajya Sabha and also Lieutenant



Governor of Puducherry, he had a distinguished public career throughout his life.

Kewalram Ratanmal Malkani was born in Hyderabad (Sindh) on 19th November 1921. He was youngest brother of famous (Padam Bhushan) Narayandas Ratanmal Malkani. Being born into politically prominent family K.R. from his early childhood was aware of importance of education and went on to earn Master's Degree in Economics and Politics from the School of Economics and Sociology in Bombay (now Mumbai). He joined D.G.National College Hyderabad as the lecturer for about three years (1945-1947) and also worked as Niemen Fellow at Harvard University (1961-62).

After the partition of the country he joined Hindustan Times as an Assistant Editor in 1948, and then became associated with weekly 'Organizer' as Editor. This association

lasted for 35 years till 1983. During his long illustrious career Malkani enjoyed and worked at various posts of journalism like first Secretary of the Editor's Guild of India (1978-79). He also worked for seven years (1983-1990) as Vice President of Deen Dayal Research Institute New Delhi and was member of India's Press Delegation to China in 1978.

He was among the founder members of Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), a political party formed in 1980. Starting from 1991, he served the party in the capacity of Vice President. He was also the member of Rajya Sabha from 1994 to 2000, during this period he worked as a member of several Parliamentary Committees. He was among the political leaders detained under Maintenance of Internal Security Act (MISA) during the emergency.

In the year 2002 on July 3rd he was sworn in as Lieutenant Governor of Puducherry, post he held till the time of his death on 27th October 2003. He is survived by two sons and a daughter.

K.R.Malkani has written many articles and books including "The Midnight Knock" (1977), "The R.S.S. Story" (1980) and "The Sindh Story" (1984), his most significant contribution towards Sindhi literature till today, many Sindhi Scholars are drawing references from this book for their writing.

His book "India First" (2002) is a compilation of some of his articles over the last several years. His last book "Political Mysteries" explore several major Indian Political assassinations including that of Mahatma Gandhi, Shyama Prasad Mukerjee, Indira Gandhi and Rajiv Gandhi.

In the words of Shri L. K. Advani, who had nearly 60 years association with K.R. Malkani "*His thinking was always guided by what he thought was in the interest of the country, He was influential writer and great thinker*".
